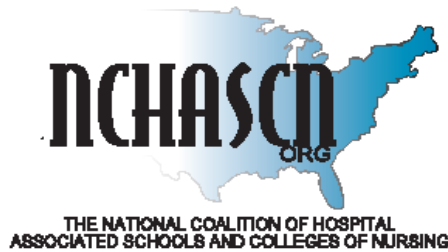
All applications must be postmarked by Friday, February 9, 2024. Grant will be awarded in April 2024 at the annual NCHASCN conference.

Faculty Grant Application for Scholarly Pursuits Guidelines

To apply for the Faculty Grant for Scholarly Pursuits, please supply the following:

- Proof of pursuit of a scholarly activity such as current enrollment in a graduate program (example – transcript, registration confirmation), proof of taking a course related to nursing education (i.e., Nurse Educator Certification) or a copy of an approved research proposal related to nursing education or a copy of nursing education program you are planning to attend. (i.e., NLN, NCLEX, ATI).
- A one-to-two-page typed, double-spaced essay explaining why you should receive the grant and what the grant will be used for. This statement should include your personal accomplishments, professional nursing goals, scholarly activities and their benefit to your colleagues, student body and the individual applicant.
- Completed application. Clearly print or type all requested information (The application can be downloaded to your computer and completed before printing)
- Current Curriculum Vitae
